

NCAA Eligibility Schedule



Academic Requirements:

- Complete 16 core classes
 - 3 years of English
 - 2 years of math (Algebra 1 or higher)
 - 2 years of natural science/physical science
 - (1 year must be lab science if you school offers it)
 - 3 additional years of English, math or natural /physical science
 - 2 years of social studies
 - 4 additional years of English, math, natural/physical science, social studies, foreign language, comparative religion or philosophy
- Minimum GPA of 2.3 (D1) & 2.2 (D2)
- Meet the minimums of the sliding scale; NCAA sliding scale uses the ACT sum score, which is calculated by combining core GPA with SAT score. Note that D1 and D2 requirements have different sliding scales.
